Boy Scouts of America – Troop 379 Sunrise Park Ski & Snowboard Trip Arizona White Mountains February 20-22, 2015



Two-night ski trip that, including all driving, starts after school on Friday and ends on Sunday evening. We'll stay in private homes in Pinetop and ski on Saturday and go sledding on Sunday morning. Lessons will be provided to inexperienced skiers and snowboarders on Saturday.

DEPOSIT DUE Feb 9th: Because lessons, lift tickets, equipment rentals and cabins will be prearranged to secure discounts and free lodging, a \$50 deposit is required for each person planning to go on this trip.

FINAL PAYMENT DUE Feb 16th: All participants must make final payment and turn in signed permission slips and equipment rental forms no later than the February 16th Scout meeting.

Sunrise Ski Park is the largest ski resort in Arizona. It includes 3 mountains, 8 lifts and 65 runs. Elevation is ~9,000' at the base and ~11,000' at top. Actual open runs and mountains depend on snow.

Cost of the Weekend: From \$95 to \$125 depending on age, experience and ski versus snowboard (snowboarding is more expensive and harder to learn). Cost covers equipment rental (skies, boots & poles or snowboard and boots), lift tickets for 1 days, 90-minute group lesson for inexperienced skiers and snowboarders, 3 group meals on Saturday, 2 group

meals on Sunday, and an auto gas contribution. Lodging is donated. Cost \$25 to \$35 lower for experienced with owned equipment. No cost for non-skiing adults (but must drive, cook & clean houses). Not a family trip.

We will talk to parents of Scouts who sign up for this trip to determine the boy's experience, obtain required rental info and provide the specific cost. Trip requires parent signed up to 3 permission and release slips: troop (over), lesson and equipment rental.

Weather: Typical February daytime temperatures on the ski slopes are from 20 to 40's °F.

What to bring: Each person must bring sleeping bag, clothes for skiing and personal hygiene stuff. Winter Clothing may be rented at REI, Ski Pro, or Alpine Ski & Snowboard in the Valley. Play-It-Again Sports often has inexpensive bibs, jackets & gloves. Also make sure you have sun block for you face and sun glasses with UV protection for your eyes. Yes, you can sunburn your eyes. Do not rent any ski or snowboard equipment in the Valley. Ski and snowboard equipment is included in the cost and will be fitted and provided at Sunrise.

Meals & Food: Bring money for Friday and Sunday dinners at fast food joints on the car trips between the church and Pinetop. All other meals on Saturday and Sunday are provided as group meals.

Transportation: Meet in Desert Cross parking lot at 3:30 pm on Friday for 4:00 pm departure. Drive to cabins is 4.5 hours.

Directions from Tempe via Payson: Loop 101 N, Loop 202 E and AZ 87 N to Payson. Then AZ 260 E through Show Low to Pinetop-Lakeside and cabins. 180 miles.

Directions from Tempe via Salt River Canyon: Loop 101 N or S, US 60 E or Loop 202 to US 60 E to Show Low. AZ 260 E through Show Low to Pinetop-Lakeside and cabins. 190 miles. Detailed map and directions to cabins will be provided to drivers.

Directions from Pinetop to Ski Park: AZ 260 E, AZ 273 S to Sunrise Ski Park.

- 1.) BSA policies: 10 scouts per adult leader, permission slips signed, and buddy system always.
