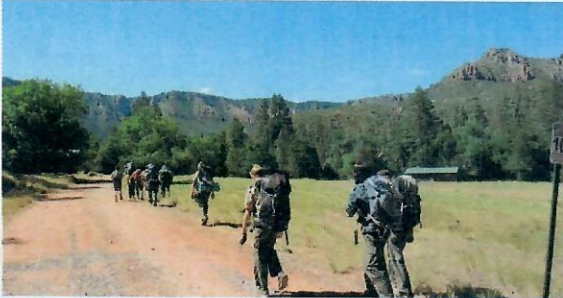


**BSA Troop 379 - Desert Cross Lutheran Church - Tempe, Arizona**

**Camp Geronimo**

**Location:** Our troop has been invited to the Safar-Ree fall camporee at Camp Geronimo near Payson, Az. This is opportunity to enjoy some unique activities, develop skills, and accomplish rank requirements! Build camaraderie with fellow Scouts and Scouters from other units! Come and test your skills and have fun in the dark, by the light of the moon!

**Weather:**

Forecasted temperatures are 50° to 80° F. Very mild but chilly at night and a lot of sun during the day.

**Cost:** The cost for this event is \$30 per person. (Adult and Youth) An additional \$5 per scout if transport is required.

**Gear:** Pack light and warm. This is a car camp, we will be assigned a campsite at the camp. Suggest sunblock and hat, good shoes for running around! With the exception of Saturday's Lunch, you will need to bring food for all other meals. **You will need to bring with you; parts A & B of the BSA Medical Form.**

**The Trip:** Take State Route 87 towards Payson. From Payson At Payson, continue

on SR 87 north. At milepost 265 take a right onto the Fire Control Road. After about 5 miles Turn left onto Nf- 440. After 0.2 miles continue left on NF- 440. In about 2 miles you will have reached Camp Geronimo!

**Activities:** Are you ready for an adventure millions of years in the making? The GCC Geronimo Fall Camporee will be happening October 18th - 20th 2024 at Camp Geronimo. It will be our Prehistoric-Ree hosted by the Black Mountain Chapter.
